1. TDA rules apply to all Venetian Poker Room poker tournaments.
2. Must be 21+ years of age and have a Venetian Rewards card to participate.
3. Fifteen (15) minute break at the completion of every four (4) levels.
4. Management reserves the right to cancel or change tournament.
5. Winners may choose to be paid in casino chips or cash.
6. Winners must show a valid ID to collect winnings. Residents of foreign countries without a U.S. tax treaty will be subject to withholding. Pursuant to IRS regulations, W-2G or 1042 forms will be issued for all tournament winnings of \$5,000 or more (net of buy-in amount).
7. \$300 Buy-In starts with 25,000 in chips. Each level is thirty (30) minutes.
8. Registration and Re-Entry is allowed for eight (8) levels & through the break.
9. \$55 of the \$300 Buy-In is withheld for house fees (Rake + Staff). The prize pool consists of \$245 of every \$300 Buy In.
10. All players will Ante every hand, and once all players receive a starting hand, action will proceed to the flop and normal betting procedures will follow from there. The minimum bet is equal to the size of the Ante and maximum bet allowed is equal to the size of the pot.
11. The button will move every hand and action will always start left of the button on the flop.
12. The highest hand shown for the top board and the highest hand shown for the bottom board will split the pot with any odd chips going to the top board winner.

13. This event will play eight (8) handed and pay 12.5% of the field.

14. A total prize pool of \$7,500 is guaranteed and "active" by the Venetian Poker Room as long as there are at least six (6) registered players by the start of the event (12:10 PM). If there are not six (6) registered players by 12:10 PM, the guarantee will not be active.

15. The tournament prize pool disbursement, as set forth herein, may be modified upon unanimous written agreement of management and of all tournament players still involved in the tournament.

16. All pre-registered stacks will be in play at the start of the event.
